What you
need:

Dino feet template

Scissors

A hole punch

A short length of string or ribbon

Crayons, glitter, feathers, paper - your choice of decoration.

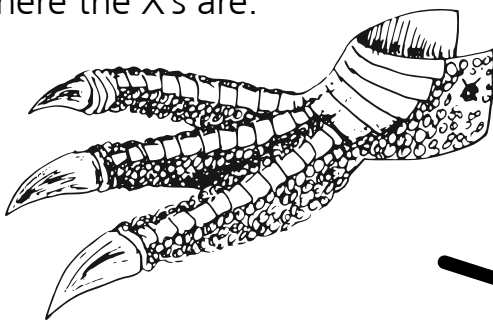
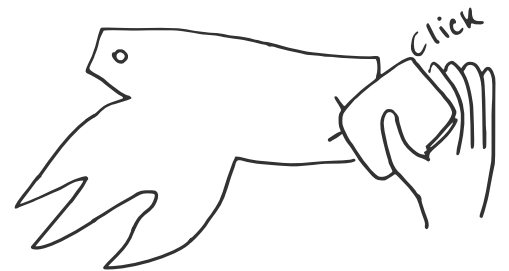
1. Choose your footprint size. Check the middle toe is a bit shorter than your shoe so that you can walk safely with your dino feet on.



2. Carefully cut out both of your dino feet.

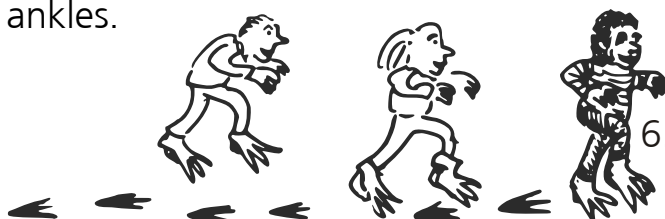


3. Find the X's at the top of each dino foot. The wide flaps will form ankle straps. Use a hole punch to cut holes where the X's are.



4. Decorate your dino feet! Look in the books to see what scientists think dinosaur feet looked like and use them for inspiration, or decide for yourself. Did dinosaurs paint their claws with glitter?

5. Your dino feet are ready to wear! Bend the card around your ankle then thread the string through both holes and tie in a bow to secure each dino foot to your ankles.



6. Walk like a dinosaur!



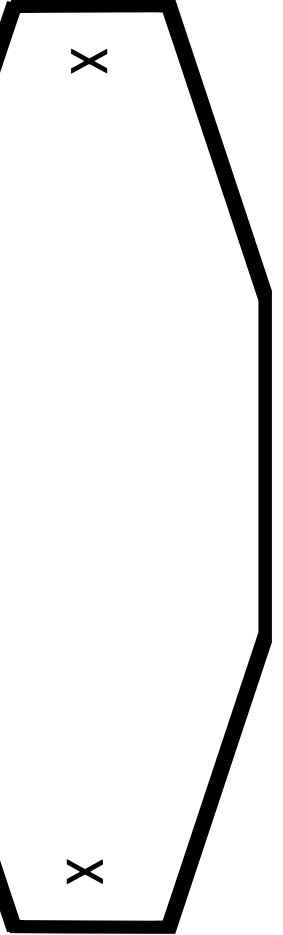
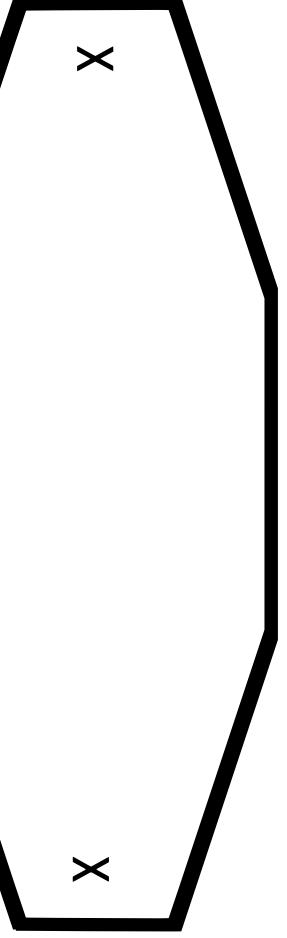
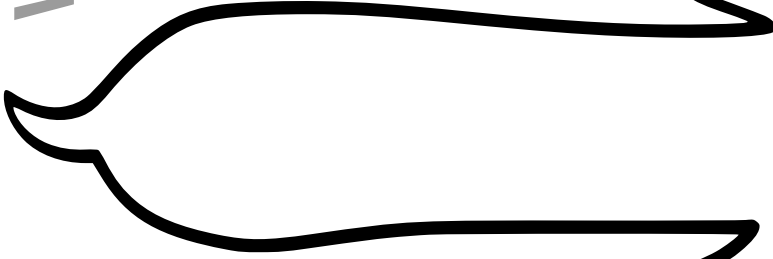
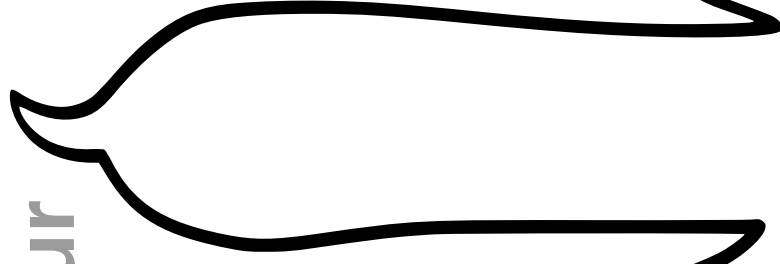
